<p>7:1-24 EVIL                      Jesus stayed in Galilee. Jews in Judea are trying to kill him. Not right time. Jesus testified world <u>does</u> evil.                      A good man. He <u>deceives</u> the people.                      Such learning! Don't judge by appearances.</p>		
	<p>7:25-32 UNKNOWN ORIGINS AND MIRACLES                      Is this the man they are trying to kill? Do the authorities believe he is the Christ?                      Knew Jesus' origins but would <u>not know where Christ was from</u>.                      Jesus refers to him who sent him, whom they did not know.                      Some tried to seize him. Others asked, Will Messiah do <u>more miracles</u>?                      Pharisees and chief priests send temple guards to arrest him.</p>	
		<p>7:33-36 YOU CANNOT COME WITH ME!                      I go to him who <u>sent me</u>.  <u>You cannot come</u>. Where is he going? To Jews amongst Greeks? What did he mean, You will look but not find me? <u>You cannot come</u>?</p>
		<p>7:37-39 COME TO ME!  <u>Come to me whoever</u> is thirsty (as in wilderness) and drink? <u>Whoever believes</u> in me rivers of living water will flow from his inner being.</p>
	<p>7:40-44 PREDICTED, KNOWN ORIGINS                      This is the Prophet (<u>Predicted</u> by Moses in the law). Others said this is the Christ. Others asked, How? Christ is of <u>David and from Bethlehem</u>.                      People divided. Some wanted to seize him.</p>	
<p>7:45-53 CURSED?                      None spoke like him.                      Are you <u>deceived</u>?                      Mob cursed, doesn't <u>know</u> law.                      Our law condemn without hearing?                      No prophet from Galilee.</p>
